## **US NATIONAL BONSAI EXHIBITION - ROCHESTER NY, JUNE 9-10**

The Third US National Bonsai Exhibition, organized by American bonsai master [William Valavanis](#), was a feast for the eyes, and well worth the 6-hour drive to Rochester, NY. The exhibit brochure listed 185 trees on display, but that didn't tell the whole story. The exhibit was presented in the formal Japanese style, which meant that each tree had a generous expanse of table space, a cloth backdrop suitable for hanging a scroll, and each tree was displayed with a carefully chosen companion planting, figurine, or stone.

The quality of the trees was truly exceptional, and there were a lot of them! Walking through the entire display, which was mounted in a spacious expo center, took more than two hours. And of course, the vendors' area and the ongoing demonstrations demanded more time. A second walk-through the next day, of both the exhibit and the sales area, was definitely a good idea.

The exhibit was judged at the end of set-up on Friday by bonsai masters *Yasuo Mitsuya* from Japan, *Marc Noelanders* from Belgium, and *Pedro Morales* from Puerto Rico. Prizes were given out at the Awards Banquet on Saturday night. In his speech at the banquet, William Valavanis gave the audience some interesting statistics:

- 353 trees belonging to 118 artists and collectors were entered for consideration
- 248 trees were accepted for the exhibit, not counting the accessories
- There were 185 individual displays, including 18 shohin displays of 3 to 5 trees in each
- Trees were displayed from 30 states, Puerto Rico, and Canada
- Bonsai artists Ryan Neil, Peter Warren, and Zack Shimon took the responsibility of transporting trees from distant parts of the country
- Attendees came from China, Japan, Australia, England, Belgium, Canada, Puerto Rico, and many of the 50 US states
- 45 volunteers did all the preparation, publicity, and set-up

Ryan Neal announced that on October 4 – 6, 2013 the Portland (Oregon) Museum of Art will host a major bonsai show, which Ryan will organize. **Mark your calendars!** And be sure not to miss Bill Valavanis' next US National Exhibition in Rochester, scheduled for September 13-14, 2014.
