The meeting was opened by President John Cotoggio at 10:40 AM and ended at 12:15 PM.

The Minutes of the last Board meeting, 7/14/2012, were discussed and approved as submitted. A Financial Report was presented by Len and discussed, by the Board.

John went through the agenda and the following were discussed:

- Updating both the newsletter and the web-site.
- Continue and increase Club shows.
- We should encourage all members to bring trees, accent plants, rocks for display, to every meeting.
- Each tree in Club shows should be photographed separately for newsletter/website display.
- John suggested that we begin a chapter of Yama Ki in Queens, New York. The group felt that initiating this in March, 2013 would give us time to get everything in place.

Membership issues:

- Len brought up the fact that every year, a small group of people join, but do not renew their membership. Jim Glatthaar is willing to do some exit interviews so we can better understand what the club needs to do to maintain new members.
